OVERVIEW OF GANG ACTIVITY IN TEXAS

GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION OF GANGS

PRISON GANGS

THE TEXAS GANG THREAT ASSESSMENT 2021 EMPHASIZES THE COORDINATION BETWEEN PRISON AND STREET GANGS IN DRUG TRAFFICKING, EXTORTION, AND VIOLENT ENFORCEMENT OF GANG RULES.

OUTLAW MOTORCYCLE GANGS

OMGs ARE SMALLER IN NUMBER BUT HOLD CONSIDERABLE POWER, ESPECIALLY IN DRUG DISTRIBUTION AND ORGANIZED CRIME. KNOWN GROUPS LIKE THE BANDIDOS AND HELLS ANGELS HAVE ESTABLISHED CHAPTERS ACROSS TEXAS. THE ASSESSMENT POINTS TO THEIR INVOLVEMENT IN NARCOTICS TRAFFICKING, WEAPONS OFFENSES, AND VIOLENT CRIME, OFTEN COORDINATING WITH OTHER CRIMINAL ENTERPRISES TO MAINTAIN THEIR INFLUENCE.

CRIMINAL ENTERPRISES AND GANG VIOLENCE

GANG-RELATED CRIMINAL ENTERPRISES FORM THE BACKBONE OF THE THREAT LANDSCAPE IN TEXAS. THE STATE'S PROXIMITY TO THE MEXICAN BORDER FACILITATES LARGE-SCALE DRUG SMUGGLING OPERATIONS, WITH GANGS CONTROLLING LOCAL DISTRIBUTION NETWORKS. THE REPORT DETAILS HOW GANG-RELATED DRUG MARKETS FUEL VIOLENCE AND ADDICTION IN AFFECTED COMMUNITIES.

VIOLENT CRIME

VIOLENT CRIME LINKED TO GANG ACTIVITY INCLUDES HOMICIDES, ASSAULTS, ROBBERIES, AND SHOOTINGS. TERRITORIAL DISPUTES, RETALIATION, AND ENFORCEMENT OF GANG RULES OFTEN ESCALATE INTO DEADLY CONFRONTATIONS. THESE DIVERSIFIED CRIMINAL ENTERPRISES ENHANCE GANG RESILIENCE AND COMPLICATE LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS.

LAW ENFORCEMENT AND COMMUNITY RESPONSE
