FEMINISM AND BODY HAIR

KARIN LESNIK OBERSTEIN'S CONTRIBUTIONS

CHALLENGES AND BACKLASH

DESPITE THE PROGRESS MADE, THE BODY HAIR MOVEMENT FACES CHALLENGES AND RESISTANCE FROM TRADITIONAL VIEWPOINTS.
