SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT

- COLLECTIVE NOUNS CAN BE SINGULAR OR PLURAL DEPENDING ON MEANING.
- INDEFINITE PRONOUNS SUCH AS “EACH,” “EVERYONE,” AND “NOBODY” REQUIRE SINGULAR VERBS.
- COMPOUND SUBJECTS JOINED BY “AND” USUALLY TAKE PLURAL VERBS.

- WHEN SUBJECTS ARE JOINED BY “OR” OR “NOR,” THE VERB AGREES WITH THE NEARER SUBJECT.

PRONOUNS AND THEIR ANTECEDENTS

CORRECT PRONOUN USAGE IS ESSENTIAL TO MAINTAIN SENTENCE CLARITY AND AVOID AMBIGUITY. THE SAT FREQUENTLY TESTS AGREEMENT BETWEEN PRONOUNS AND THEIR ANTECEDENTS, FOCUSING ON NUMBER, PERSON, AND GENDER CONSISTENCY.

PRONOUN-ANTECEDENT AGREEMENT

PRONOUNS MUST AGREE IN NUMBER AND GENDER WITH THE NOUNS THEY REPLACE. SINGULAR ANTECEDENTS REQUIRE SINGULAR PRONOUNS, AND PLURAL ANTECEDENTS REQUIRE PLURAL PRONOUNS. MISTAKES IN THIS AREA CAN LEAD TO CONFUSING OR GRAMMATICALLY INCORRECT SENTENCES.

AMBIGUOUS AND VAGUE PRONOUN REFERENCES

THE SAT ALSO ASSESSES THE CLARITY OF PRONOUN REFERENCES. AMBIGUOUS PRONOUNS THAT COULD REFER TO MORE THAN ONE ANTECEDENT OR HAVE NO CLEAR ANTECEDENT ARE CONSIDERED INCORRECT. CLEAR, SPECIFIC PRONOUN REFERENCES IMPROVE SENTENCE COHERENCE.

VERB TENSES AND VERB FORMS

- USE COMMAS TO SET OFF NONESSENTIAL CLAUSES AND PHRASES.
- USE SEMICOLONS TO LINK INDEPENDENT CLAUSES WITHOUT CONJUNCTIONS.
- USE COLONS TO INTRODUCE LISTS OR EXPLANATIONS FOLLOWING AN INDEPENDENT CLAUSE.

SENTENCE STRUCTURE AND CLARITY

EFFECTIVE SENTENCE COMBINING
