

TN HUNTING AND TRAPPING GUIDE

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TENNESSEE, WITH ITS DIVERSE LANDSCAPES RANGING FROM THE APPALACHIAN MOUNTAINS TO FERTILE VALLEYS, OFFERS A RICH ARRAY OF WILDLIFE AND OUTDOOR OPPORTUNITIES. FOR BOTH SEASONED HUNTERS AND NOVICES, UNDERSTANDING THE INTRICACIES OF HUNTING AND TRAPPING IN TENNESSEE CAN ENHANCE YOUR EXPERIENCE AND ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH LOCAL REGULATIONS. THIS GUIDE WILL PROVIDE ESSENTIAL INFORMATION ON HUNTING AND TRAPPING, INCLUDING REGULATIONS, SPECIES IDENTIFICATION, GEAR RECOMMENDATIONS, AND ETHICAL PRACTICES.

UNDERSTANDING TENNESSEE'S HUNTING REGULATIONS

BEFORE EMBARKING ON YOUR HUNTING OR TRAPPING ADVENTURE, IT IS CRUCIAL TO FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH TENNESSEE'S HUNTING REGULATIONS. THESE RULES ARE DESIGNED TO ENSURE SUSTAINABLE WILDLIFE POPULATIONS AND PROTECT THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT.

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

TO HUNT OR TRAP IN TENNESSEE, YOU MUST POSSESS THE APPROPRIATE LICENSES. HERE ARE THE KEY LICENSING REQUIREMENTS:

1. HUNTING LICENSE: REQUIRED FOR ALL HUNTERS AGED 13 AND OLDER. DIFFERENT LICENSES ARE AVAILABLE BASED ON RESIDENCY STATUS (RESIDENT OR NON-RESIDENT) AND THE TYPE OF GAME PURSUED.
2. TRAPPING LICENSE: REQUIRED FOR ANYONE WHO TRAPS FURBEARERS. THIS LICENSE CAN BE OBTAINED SEPARATELY FROM THE HUNTING LICENSE.
3. HUNTER EDUCATION COURSE: MANDATORY FOR HUNTERS BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1969. COMPLETION OF A CERTIFIED HUNTER EDUCATION COURSE IS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A HUNTING LICENSE.

SEASON DATES AND BAG LIMITS

EACH SPECIES HAS SPECIFIC HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS. HERE ARE SOME EXAMPLES:

- DEER: ARCHERY SEASON TYPICALLY OPENS IN LATE SEPTEMBER; GUN SEASON USUALLY BEGINS IN MID-NOVEMBER. THE BAG LIMIT VARIES BY ZONE.
- WILD TURKEY: SPRING TURKEY SEASON GENERALLY RUNS FROM MID-APRIL TO LATE MAY.
- SMALL GAME: SEASONS FOR SPECIES LIKE SQUIRRELS AND RABBITS VARY, OFTEN RUNNING FROM LATE SUMMER THROUGH WINTER.

ALWAYS CHECK THE LATEST REGULATIONS FROM THE TENNESSEE WILDLIFE RESOURCES AGENCY (TWRA) FOR UPDATES ON SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS.

IDENTIFYING KEY GAME SPECIES

TENNESSEE'S DIVERSE ECOSYSTEMS SUPPORT A VARIETY OF GAME SPECIES. UNDERSTANDING THE HABITS AND HABITATS OF THESE ANIMALS WILL HELP YOU IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF A SUCCESSFUL HUNT.

BIG GAME

1. WHITE-TAILED DEER: THE MOST POPULAR BIG GAME ANIMAL IN TENNESSEE. THEY INHABIT FORESTS, FIELDS, AND WETLANDS.
2. WILD TURKEY: KNOWN FOR THEIR ELUSIVE NATURE, WILD TURKEYS PREFER OPEN WOODLANDS AND FIELDS.

SMALL GAME

1. EASTERN GRAY SQUIRREL: COMMONLY FOUND IN HARDWOOD FORESTS. THEY ARE ACTIVE YEAR-ROUND.
2. COTTONTAIL RABBIT: OFTEN FOUND IN BRUSHY AREAS AND FIELDS. THEY ARE MOST ACTIVE DURING DAWN AND DUSK.

FURBEARERS

FURBEARERS ARE A POPULAR TARGET FOR TRAPPERS. KEY SPECIES INCLUDE:

- RACCOONS
- COYOTES
- BEAVERS
- FOXES

ESSENTIAL GEAR FOR HUNTING AND TRAPPING

HAVING THE PROPER GEAR IS CRUCIAL FOR A SUCCESSFUL AND SAFE HUNTING OR TRAPPING EXPERIENCE. BELOW ARE RECOMMENDED ITEMS FOR BOTH ACTIVITIES.

HUNTING GEAR

1. FIREARMS/BOWS: CHOOSE THE APPROPRIATE WEAPON BASED ON THE GAME YOU ARE PURSUING.
2. CLOTHING: WEAR WEATHER-APPROPRIATE CLOTHING IN LAYERS, AND CONSIDER CAMOUFLAGE PATTERNS SUITED TO YOUR ENVIRONMENT.
3. SAFETY GEAR: ALWAYS WEAR A BLAZE ORANGE VEST OR HAT DURING FIREARM SEASONS TO ENHANCE VISIBILITY.
4. ACCESSORIES: BINOCULARS, A HUNTING KNIFE, AND A BACKPACK FOR CARRYING ESSENTIALS.

TRAPPING GEAR

1. TRAPS: DECIDE ON THE TYPE OF TRAPS YOU WILL USE (E.G., BODY-GRIPPING TRAPS, FOOTHOLD TRAPS, OR CAGE TRAPS).
2. BAIT: USE SPECIES-SPECIFIC BAIT TO ATTRACT THE TARGET ANIMAL EFFECTIVELY.
3. TOOLS: CARRY TOOLS FOR SETTING TRAPS, SUCH AS A STAKE PULLER AND A SIFTER FOR GROUND TRAPS.

ETHICAL HUNTING AND TRAPPING PRACTICES

RESPECT FOR WILDLIFE AND THE ENVIRONMENT IS PARAMOUNT. PRACTICING ETHICAL HUNTING AND TRAPPING ENSURES THE SUSTAINABILITY OF WILDLIFE POPULATIONS AND PROMOTES A POSITIVE IMAGE OF THE HUNTING COMMUNITY.

FAIR CHASE PRINCIPLES

- KNOW YOUR LIMITS: ONLY TAKE SHOTS YOU ARE CONFIDENT YOU CAN MAKE. AVOID WOUNDING ANIMALS.
- RESPECT OTHER HUNTERS: MAINTAIN A SAFE DISTANCE AND RESPECT OTHERS' HUNTING SPACES.
- LEAVE NO TRACE: CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF AND DO NOT DISTURB THE NATURAL HABITAT.

TRAPPING ETHICS

- CHECK TRAPS REGULARLY: FOLLOW STATE REGULATIONS REGARDING HOW OFTEN TRAPS MUST BE CHECKED.
- USE HUMANE TRAPS: SELECT TRAPS DESIGNED TO MINIMIZE SUFFERING FOR CAPTURED ANIMALS.
- BE MINDFUL OF NON-TARGET SPECIES: USE TRAPS THAT ARE LESS LIKELY TO CATCH NON-TARGET ANIMALS, AND KNOW WHAT TO DO IF THEY ARE INADVERTENTLY TRAPPED.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

HUNTING AND TRAPPING CAN BE EXHILARATING, BUT SAFETY SHOULD ALWAYS BE A PRIORITY. HERE ARE SOME ESSENTIAL SAFETY TIPS:

1. WEAR APPROPRIATE GEAR: ALWAYS WEAR BLAZE ORANGE DURING HUNTING SEASONS TO INCREASE VISIBILITY.
2. KNOW YOUR FIREARM: FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THE OPERATION AND SAFETY FEATURES OF YOUR FIREARM OR BOW.
3. STAY AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS: BE MINDFUL OF OTHER HUNTERS AND WILDLIFE.
4. FIRST AID KIT: CARRY A FIRST AID KIT IN CASE OF EMERGENCIES.

RESOURCES AND SUPPORT

SEVERAL RESOURCES ARE AVAILABLE TO HELP YOU PREPARE FOR YOUR HUNTING AND TRAPPING EXPERIENCES IN TENNESSEE:

- TENNESSEE WILDLIFE RESOURCES AGENCY (TWRA): PROVIDES UP-TO-DATE INFORMATION ON REGULATIONS, LICENSES, AND WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT.
- LOCAL HUNTING CLUBS: JOINING A LOCAL HUNTING OR TRAPPING CLUB CAN PROVIDE VALUABLE INSIGHTS AND CAMARADERIE.
- ONLINE FORUMS: ENGAGING IN ONLINE COMMUNITIES CAN OFFER ADVICE AND TIPS FROM EXPERIENCED HUNTERS AND TRAPPERS.
