PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- ENHANCING LEADERSHIP AND COMMUNICATION ABILITIES
- ENCOURAGING COLLABORATION ACROSS DIVERSE PUBLIC HEALTH SECTORS

ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION PROCESS

THE UCLA PUBLIC HEALTH SCHOLARS TRAINING PROGRAM SEEKS APPLICANTS WITH A STRONG COMMITMENT TO ADVANCING PUBLIC HEALTH KNOWLEDGE AND PRACTICE. CANDIDATES ARE TYPICALLY UNDERGRADUATE OR GRADUATE STUDENTS WITH ACADEMIC BACKGROUNDS IN HEALTH SCIENCES, SOCIAL SCIENCES, BIOLOGY, OR RELATED FIELDS. THE PROGRAM IS COMPETITIVE, EMPHASIZING ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE, RELEVANT EXPERIENCE, AND DEMONSTRATED INTEREST IN PUBLIC HEALTH.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT A COMPREHENSIVE APPLICATION PACKAGE THAT GENERALLY INCLUDES:

- OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS FROM CURRENT AND PREVIOUS ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS
- A STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OUTLINING THE CANDIDATE'S INTEREST IN PUBLIC HEALTH AND CAREER GOALS
- LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION FROM ACADEMIC OR PROFESSIONAL REFERENCES
- RESUME OR CURRICULUM VITAE HIGHLIGHTING RELEVANT COURSEWORK AND EXPERIENCE
- STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES, IF APPLICABLE

SELECTION CRITERIA

THE SELECTION COMMITTEE EVALUATES CANDIDATES BASED ON SEVERAL FACTORS, INCLUDING:

- ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE AND GPA
- RELEVANT RESEARCH OR PUBLIC HEALTH EXPERIENCE
- CLARITY AND MOTIVATION EXPRESSED IN THE PERSONAL STATEMENT
- POTENTIAL FOR LEADERSHIP AND IMPACT IN THE FIELD OF PUBLIC HEALTH

CURRICULUM AND TRAINING COMPONENTS

THE CURRICULUM OF THE UCLA PUBLIC HEALTH SCHOLARS TRAINING PROGRAM INTEGRATES FOUNDATIONAL PUBLIC HEALTH CONCEPTS WITH SPECIALIZED TRAINING TAILORED TO THE INTERESTS OF EACH SCHOLAR. THE PROGRAM EMPHASIZES EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING THROUGH COURSEWORK, SEMINARS, AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITIES.

RESEARCH AND MENTORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

RESEARCH IS A CORNERSTONE OF THE UCLA PUBLIC HEALTH SCHOLARS TRAINING PROGRAM, ENABLING SCHOLARS TO CONTRIBUTE TO ADVANCING PUBLIC HEALTH SCIENCE. THE PROGRAM FOSTERS A RICH ENVIRONMENT FOR SCHOLARLY INQUIRY THROUGH ACCESS TO FACULTY MENTORS AND RESEARCH PROJECTS.

FACULTY MENTORSHIP

EACH SCHOLAR IS PAIRED WITH EXPERIENCED FACULTY MENTORS WHO PROVIDE GUIDANCE ON RESEARCH DESIGN, DATA ANALYSIS, AND CAREER PLANNING. THIS MENTORSHIP FACILITATES SCHOLARLY GROWTH AND HELPS SCHOLARS NAVIGATE THE COMPLEXITIES OF PUBLIC HEALTH CHALLENGES.

RESEARCH PROJECTS

SCHOLARS ENGAGE IN DIVERSE RESEARCH INITIATIVES ADDRESSING TOPICS SUCH AS INFECTIOUS DISEASE CONTROL, HEALTH DISPARITIES, ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH RISKS, AND CHRONIC DISEASE PREVENTION. OPPORTUNITIES EXIST TO COLLABORATE ON ONGOING PROJECTS OR DEVELOP INDEPENDENT RESEARCH UNDER FACULTY SUPERVISION.

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS, PARTICULARLY THOSE INTERESTED IN PUBLIC HEALTH AND RELATED FIELDS, ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY. APPLICANTS TYPICALLY NEED TO DEMONSTRATE A STRONG ACADEMIC RECORD AND A COMMITMENT TO PUBLIC HEALTH.

WHAT ARE THE MAIN COMPONENTS OF THE UCLA PUBLIC HEALTH SCHOLARS TRAINING PROGRAM?

THE PROGRAM INCLUDES RESEARCH TRAINING, MENTORSHIP FROM FACULTY, PUBLIC HEALTH WORKSHOPS, SEMINARS, AND OPPORTUNITIES TO ENGAGE IN COMMUNITY HEALTH PROJECTS.

HOW LONG DOES THE UCLA PUBLIC HEALTH SCHOLARS TRAINING PROGRAM LAST?

THE PROGRAM USUALLY RUNS FOR ONE ACADEMIC YEAR OR SUMMER SESSION, DEPENDING ON THE SPECIFIC COHORT AND PROGRAM STRUCTURE.

WHAT BENEFITS DO PARTICIPANTS GAIN FROM THE UCLA PUBLIC HEALTH SCHOLARS TRAINING PROGRAM?

STUDENTS CAN APPLY THROUGH THE OFFICIAL UCLA FIELDING SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH WEBSITE BY SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION FORM, TRANSCRIPTS, LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION, AND A PERSONAL STATEMENT.
