UNDERSTANDING VOCABULARY INSTRUCTION AND THE SCIENCE OF READING

- **TIERED VOCABULARY:** CATEGORIZED INTO THREE LEVELS BASED ON FREQUENCY AND COMPLEXITY, GUIDING INSTRUCTIONAL FOCUS.

KEY COMPONENTS OF EFFECTIVE VOCABULARY INSTRUCTION

THIS ENSURES STUDENTS ENCOUNTER NEW WORDS IN A STRUCTURED MANNER, FACILITATING RETENTION AND APPLICATION. THE SCIENCE OF READING ADVOCATES FOR PLANNED VOCABULARY LESSONS RATHER THAN INCIDENTAL OR SOLELY CONTEXT-BASED LEARNING.

CONTEXTUAL AND CONCEPTUAL UNDERSTANDING

MULTIPLE EXPOSURES AND ACTIVE ENGAGEMENT

RESEARCH SUPPORTS THAT LEARNERS NEED MULTIPLE EXPOSURES TO NEW WORDS TO FULLY ACQUIRE THEIR MEANINGS. VOCABULARY INSTRUCTION SHOULD INCLUDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR ACTIVE ENGAGEMENT SUCH AS DISCUSSIONS, WRITING ACTIVITIES, AND INTERACTIVE TASKS THAT ENCOURAGE USAGE AND REINFORCEMENT.

STRATEGIES FOR TEACHING VOCABULARY WITHIN THE SCIENCE OF READING FRAMEWORK
