8. *"THINGS FALL APART"* BY CHINUA ACHEBE

THIS NOVEL EXPLORES THE LIFE OF OKONKWO, A PROUD IGBO WARRIOR IN PRE-COLONIAL NIGERIA, AND THE IMPACT OF BRITISH COLONIALISM ON HIS COMMUNITY. IT PROVIDES A POWERFUL LOOK AT AFRICAN TRADITIONS, CULTURE, AND THE CLASH BETWEEN INDIGENOUS AND COLONIAL VALUES. THE BOOK IS A STAPLE IN WORLD LITERATURE FOR ITS INSIGHTFUL PORTRAYAL OF CULTURAL CHANGE AND CONFLICT.

9. *"THE METAMORPHOSIS"* BY FRANZ KAFKA

THIS NOVELLA TELLS THE SURREAL STORY OF GREGOR SAMSA, WHO WAKES UP ONE MORNING TRANSFORMED INTO A GIANT INSECT. IT EXPLORES THEMES OF ALIENATION, IDENTITY, AND THE ABSURDITY OF HUMAN EXISTENCE. KAFKA'S WORK IS CRITICAL FOR UNDERSTANDING MODERNIST LITERATURE AND EXISTENTIALIST THOUGHT.

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
