THE SPEAKER INCLUDES ANECDOTES AND REAL-LIFE EXAMPLES TO ILLUSTRATE HIS POINTS, GROUNDING ABSTRACT IDEAS IN CONCRETE EXPERIENCES. THESE STORIES HELP TO CONTEXTUALIZE THE THEMES AND MAKE THE SPEECH MORE IMPACTFUL.
